**General Statement:** The Fire and Life Safety Officer I (Health Facilities Construction) serves as a trainee participating in a prescribed fire and life safety instruction plan and will observe the construction of and perform, preliminary, triage, normal, expedite, and over-the-counter reviews of submittal documents pertaining to the design and construction of healthcare facilities as required to ensure compliance with Title 24, California Code of Regulations (CCR), the Division's Policy Intent Notices (PINs), Code Application Notices (CANs), and other applicable codes; conducts field triage and reviews of plans and specifications; monitors the inspection work of Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) certified Inspectors of Record (IORs) and advises project participants on design and construction methods, techniques, materials and code related matters.

## Duties:

- Attend and complete all training courses, seminars and other forms of instruction as prescribed in the Fire and Life Safety Trainee instruction plan.
- Participate in supervised on-the-job plan review training to obtain the skills, knowledge and job experience required to successfully perform Fire and Life Safety plan review of submittal documents pertaining to the design and construction of healthcare facilities.
- Prepare reports, correspondence and other communication as necessary to perform assigned duties.
- Participate in supervised on-the-job construction observation training to obtain the skills, knowledge and job experience required to successfully perform Fire and Life Safety construction observation of healthcare facility fire and life safety systems and construction requirements.

## Desirable Qualifications:

- Working knowledge of Title 19 and 24 California Code of Regulations, National Fire Codes, and other fire and life safety standards applicable to healthcare facilities.
- Experience in plan review and field review/observation.
- Working knowledge of computers and applicable software programs.
- Ability to communicate well with others and to handle sensitive issues with tact and diplomacy.
- Clean driving record. *Must submit an official driving history from the California Department of Motor Vehicles prior to appointment.*
- Ability to develop detailed reports.
- Ability to handle multiple priorities and deadlines.

## Who May Apply:

Applications will be accepted from individuals currently in the class or who have list, transfer or reinstatement eligibility to the class or who meet the minimum qualifications for appointment (pending competition in a state civil service examination). Applicants with list appointment should attach a copy of their notice of test results. (Applicants who are eligible to apply for registration will be admitted into the examination but must possess a valid certificate of registration to be eligible for appointment.) The minimum qualifications are: Two years of experience performing full-time plan review and/or technical inspection or supervision of general construction projects for fire and life safety compliance in a public or private fire prevention agency OR equivalent to graduation from an accredited four-year college with a major in fire service administration, fire protection administration and technology, engineering, chemistry, physics, or architecture. Additional qualifying experience may substitute for education on a year-for-year basis.)
